Goal: Is to reduce the number of successful illegal purchases by minors to no more than 20 percent of attempted buys by minors in New Mexico.



Attention Youth

Are you interested in participating in the Synar Program? If so, New Mexico communities can use your help. The Synar Program seeks youth 15 and 16 years of age, both male and female, of all Races and Cultural backgrounds. Youth will be matched up with a Prevention Program closest to their residence and will be trained to conduct non-consummated compliance inspections. These inspections consist of trained youth entering tobacco merchant establishments to request to purchase tobacco in an effort to identify and educate clerks that do not ask for ID and are willing to sell to youth under the age of 18. Youth will also be given incentives for participation.
