



!!! TAX AND REBATE ALERT !!!

The government may owe you a refund on your federal or state taxes or you may be entitled to receive a rebate. You must file a tax return and use IRS Form 1040 or 1040A. There are several organizations that can help you file your tax return. A few are listed below. The deadline for filing federal and state tax returns is April 15, 2010.



You could qualify for federal tax credits whether you owe income taxes or not:

- Up to \$400 (or up to \$800 for a joint return) for the Making Work Pay Tax Credit
- Up to \$4,824 from the Federal Earned Income Tax Credit
- Up to \$1,000 per child from the Federal Child Tax Credit
- Up to \$3,000 from the Federal Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit
- Up to \$2,500 of college tuition and related education expenses
- Up to \$8,000 for your first home purchase
- Credits for energy efficient home improvements and electric vehicles
- Deductions for taxes you paid on a new vehicle

Persons with a modified gross income of:

- \$16,000 or less who are age 65 or older may qualify for the New Mexico Property Tax Rebate
- \$30,160 or less may qualify for the New Mexico Child Day Care Credit
- \$22,000 or less may qualify for the Low Income Comprehensive Tax Rebate
- \$24,000 or less who live in Los Alamos County or Santa Fe County ONLY may qualify for a Low Income Property Tax Rebate
