V. BACKGROUND SUMMARY

The Human Services Department (the Department), through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is proposing to amend New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC) rule 8.206.400.

NMAC Highlights:

- Section 10 has been added to offer a Medical Assistance Programs (MAP) category of eligibility to adults who are former foster care children, who now reside in New Mexico, are under 26 years of age and received MAP services in New Mexico or another state.
- The Department is taking this opportunity to standardize language throughout the rule which does not alter the current manner in which eligibility is determined.

VI. RULE

VII. EFFECTIVE DATE

The Department proposes an effective date of October 1, 2015 for this rule.
