Affidavits
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The New Mexico Human Services Department Medical Assistance Division is providing this notice for the purpose of receiving comments on payment rate reductions to hospitals related to the safety net care pool which is part of the final Diagnosis Related Group (DRG) payment made to hospitals. DRG rates were previously increased as counties were providing a portion of the DRG payment for the safety net care pool including quality improvements. The total required amount from the counties that have been supporting those hospitals is equivalent to 1/8 of a percent of the gross receipts, the entire tax increment that counties use and dedicate to indigent care. However, counties chose not to relinquish the entire portion of that tax increment. During the 2014 Regular Session for FY 2015 budget year, the Legislature, in a compromise, diverted an equivalent of 1/12 of a percent from those counties to support the safety care pool and DRG rate increase along with \$9 million of
