SUBJECT: STATE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH FEE SCHEDULE

On June 28, 2023, the New Mexico Human Services Department (HSD) announced its intention to update the Behavioral Health Fee Schedule to reflect new program implementations and provider rate increase effective July 1, 2023.

New program implementations include:

- High-Fidelity Wraparound services;
- Expanded Mobile Crisis services; and
- Mobile Response and Stabilization Services for Children.

Enhanced rates for the following evidence-based practices:

- Multi-Systemic Therapy (MST);
- Functional Family Therapy (FFT);
- Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT);
- Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR); and
- Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT).

Additionally, this fee schedule incorporates payment rate increases outlined in House Bill 2 (HB2). HSD believes these rate adjustments will help build and protect the New Mexico Medicaid health care delivery network. The proposed rate increases were supported, endorsed and funded by the New Mexico Legislature during the 2023 regular session.

Providers should use the attached fee schedule to submit claims from the date of this Supplement going forward.

The MCOs were directed to reconfigure their systems to implement the updated fee schedule rate increases effective July 1, 2023.
