This is an amendment to 8.200.510 NMAC, Sections 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15, effective 4/1/2021.

COMMUNITY SPOUSE RESOURCE ALLOWANCE (CSRA): The CSRA standard varies based on when the applicant or recipient become institutionalized for a continuous period. The CSRA remains constant even if it was calculated prior to submission of a formal MAP application. If institutionalization began:
