The Human Services Department (the Department), Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is proposing amendments to 8.200.410 Medicaid Eligibility-General Recipient Polices of the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC). The Department is taking this opportunity to amend 8.200.410 NMAC as follows:

• Section 15 – new language to allow an inmates who has an established MAP category of eligibility to be approved for a MAP category of inmate eligibility throughout his or her incarceration; and to allow an inmate who does not a have an established MAP category of eligibility upon his or her arrival at a public institution to apply for MAP category of inmate eligibility. This would allow an inmate to have access to MAD services at his or her discharge or release from a public institution.

The Department proposes to have 8.200.410 NMAC effective October 1, 2015. A public hearing to receive testimony on these proposed rules will be held in Hearing Room One, Toney Anaya Building, 2550 Cerrillos Road Santa Fe, NM on August 31, 2015, 10 a.m. Mountain Daylight Time (MDT).
