

Monthly Statistical Report March 2017

Highlights

- The SNAP caseload in March 2017 was 238,911, a 4.1 percent decrease from one year ago. The SNAP caseload has decreased by 16,278 cases or 6.4 percent, since last month.
- The TANF caseload was 11,631 in March 2017 a decrease of 3.5 percent from March 2016. The TANF caseload had 335 cases less than February 2017, a decrease of 2.8 percent.
- The caseload for General Assistance was 3,516 in March 2017, an increase of 9.4 percent from one year ago and a decrease of 31 cases from last month.












NM Works Activity Placements on March 31, 2017 as reported by SL Start **

Average Starting Hourly Wage of March 2017 TANF Employments, as reported by SL Start






