

Monthly Statistical Report December 2016

Highlights

- The SNAP caseload in December 2016 was 257,010, a 6.3 percent increase from one year ago. The SNAP caseload has decreased by 2,810 cases or 1.1 percent, since last month.
- The TANF caseload was 12,400 in December 2016 a decrease of 2.2 percent from December 2015. The TANF caseload had 126 cases less than November 2016, a decrease of 1.0 percent.
- The caseload for General Assistance was 3,538 in December 2016, an increase of 7.1 percent from one year ago and a decrease of 12 cases from last month.












NM Works Activity Placements on December 31, 2016 as reported by SL Start **



Average Starting Hourly Wage of December 2016 TANF Employments, as reported by SL Start




