

LIHEAP FACT SHEET

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a grant from U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). LIHEAP helps low income New Mexicans pay for home heating and cooling costs one time each program year.

1. Funding

▶ New Mexico Grantees

- o New Mexico Human Services Department
- Five Sandoval, Laguna, Jemez, Jicarilla, Nambe and Zuni Tribes/Pueblos-\$170,480.00 (FFY 2015)

▶ Requirements

- o Moratorium on utility shut offs is in effect from November 15 to March 15
- o Program benefits must be available through March 15th
- o 10% Administrative Cost Limit
- o 10% Carry Forward Limit

▶ Options

o No more than 15% for weatherization services
