



New Mexico operates the Medicaid Mi Via waiver pursuant to Section 1915(c) of the Social Security Act. Section 1915(c) waivers provide home and community-based services to persons who, if not for the waiver, would be placed in an intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF-IID). Mi Via is a recipient self-directed waiver that serves the ICF-IID population including persons who are developmentally disabled (DD) or medically fragile (MF).

Mi Via waiver 0448 is currently operating on an extension approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) through March 29, 2015. HSD, in partnership with the Department of Health (DOH), submitted its waiver renewal application on November 14, 2014 for a new five-year waiver period retroactive to October 1, 2014. HSD anticipates CMS approval of the renewal application by mid-February 2015.
