

TANF SUN PATH Program Fact Sheet

1. Purpose of TANF SUN PATH?

The Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Skill Up Network Pathway Acceleration in Technology and Healthcare (SUN PATH) Program which provides a TANF participant the opportunity to obtain a certificate or associate's degree that will allow them to gain and retain full-time employment in a healthcare-related field.

2. Funding

Legislative appropriation through the Human Services Department (HSD)/Income Support Division (ISD) provided \$1,000,000 in funding from the TANF Block Grant for Fiscal Year 2017 for the TANF SUN PATH program.

3. Eligibility

In addition to receiving TANF, the participant must be mandatory for New Mexico Works (NMW) to qualify for the program.

4. Referral Process

The NMW Service Provider, SL Start, will refer eligible participants to the program based on the participant's education goals. The participant will be referred if they express interest in one of the certificate or associate programs offered by the TANF SUN PATH program.

5. Description of the Program

The TANF SUN PATH program is offered at 13 higher education institutions across New Mexico. The participant will work with an Educational Coordinator to ensure they are on track for graduation and a Job Development Career Coach (JDCC) employed through the Department of Workforce Solutions (DWS) throughout the program to prepare them for a career upon graduation.

The program will assist in paying tuition, books and fees, if the participant does not qualify for financial aid.
