The Human Services Department (the Department), Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is proposing to amend a rule that is part of the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC): 8.308.10 *Care Coordination*. The Department is standardizing the Health Risk Assessment tool across all Managed Care Organizations (MCOs). In addition, on April 1, 2016, the Department is implementing a Health Home initiative that includes additional care coordination requirements for Health Home members. The Department will outline specific care coordination requirements in the Centennial Care Policy Manual. Section 9 Care Coordination: sections B through K proposed language has been removed and will be defined in the Centennial Care Policy Manual.
