More Immigrant Children to Benefit from State's Food Stamp Program

The rules have changed, and as of October 1st, the parents of thousands of legal immigrant children living in New Mexico can apply for food stamps for their children, whether the parents are eligible or not and no matter how long their children have lived in the US. The food stamp program already helps over 115,000 kids eat healthy and nutritious food.

If you live in New Mexico and have legal immigrant children, please contact your local Human Services Department Income Support Office or call 1-800-283-4465 to apply or find out more about how you too can increase your household's income with food stamps. Remember, you do not have to be eligible for food stamps in order for your children to get them.
