New Mexico Interagency Behavioral Health Collaborative Meeting Scheduled for Tuesday, July 19 in Santa Fe

Santa Fe, July 11, 2005 - The monthly meeting of the New Mexico Interagency Behavioral Health Purchasing Collaborative (Collaborative) is scheduled for **Tuesday, July 19, 2005 from 1 to 5:15 p.m. at the State Capitol, room 307.**

The Collaborative, which consists of 15 state agencies that provide and/or fund public mental health and substance abuse services, will get a status report on the implementation of the new behavioral health system of care through the statewide entity, which began July 1, 2005.
