V. BACKGROUND SUMMARY

The Human Services Department (the Department), through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is proposing to amend 8.290.500 NMAC, *Income and Resource Standards*. The amendment corrects citations found within 8.290.500.15 through 8.290.500.22 and has no language changes.
