V. BACKGROUND SUMMARY

The Human Services Department (the Department), through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is proposing to amend the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC) rule 8.311.3 NMAC, *Methods and Standards for Establishing Payment - Inpatient Hospital Services*. The rule is being amended to address available state and federal funding.

Highlights by Section

Section 8.311.3.12(F)(6), relating to the Sole Community provider program, and 8.311.3.12(F)(7), State operated teaching hospital adjustment, will be removed in their entirety and the remainder of the section will be renumbered.

Section 8.311.3.12(F)(8) and (9) and Section 8.311.3.13(C) adds language to address state and federal funding availability.

VI. RULE

VII. EFFECTIVE DATE

The Department proposes to implement this rule effective May 1, 2016.
