RE: Tribal Notification to Request Advice and Comments Letter 23-22:

Dear Tribal Leadership, Indian Health Service, Tribal Health Providers, and Other Interested Parties:

Seeking advice and comments from New Mexico's Indian Nations, Tribes, Pueblos and their health care providers is an important component of the government-to-government relationship with the State of New Mexico. In accordance with the New Mexico Human Services Department's (HSD's) Tribal Notification to Request Advice and Comments process, this letter is to inform you that HSD, through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is accepting comments until **5:00 p.m. Mountain Time (MT) January 21 2024**, regarding state plan amendment (SPA) **23-0017 Chiropractic Services**.

The New Mexico Human Services Department Medical Assistance Division is providing notice on plans to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) request to reimburse chiropractic services, for all individuals who have a primary diagnosis of neck pain, back pain, musculoskeletal pain, or headaches that are not eligible for Long-term Support Services (LTSS) through Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) and Mi Via programs, in which these services are already covered, effective January 1, 2024.

Tribal Impact

HSD does not anticipate a negative impact for Indian Nations, Tribes, and Pueblos and their health care providers.
