V. BACKGROUND

• The New Mexico Human Services Department is amending regulation at 8.139.503 NMAC, New Mexico Modified Combined Application Project (NMCAP). This action is based upon the program's federal sunset clause. The NMAC provision is being repealed at the end of participants' 3 year finite program eligibility. Participants still eligible will remain on the program without a change to their benefits through the end of their certification period.

The New Mexico Human Services Department (HSD) will hold a public hearing to allow public comment on the amendment of 8.139.503 New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC). This is the PROPOSED amendment to 8.139.503 NMAC, Section 5

8.139.503.5 EFFECTIVE DATE: [June 1, 2009, unless a later date is cited at the end of a section.] This pilot program has a sunset effective May 2014. NMCAP cases that are eligible via the program's parameters remain effective until the end of their 3 year eligibility. Active NMCAP cases past their 3 year eligibility via this program will be eligible to apply to receive regular SNAP.
