This memorandum is to provide clarification from the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) regarding restrictive language on I-94s issued to certain Haitians by Immigration and Customers Enforcement (ICE).

ICE has issued I-94s to certain Haitians that indicate parole, but also contain the following language:

"This form does not convey authorization to receive any type of public benefit."

A Haitian with a <u>current or expired parole</u> meets the definition of Haitian Entrant as defined in section 501(e) of the Refugee Education assistance Act of 1980. Haitian Entrants are eligible for ORR benefits and services. An I-94 of a Haitian that indicates a current or expired parole is documentary evidence of Haitian Entrant status. The presence on the I-94 of the language above does not alter or override ORR's regulations or guidance. Such language does not invalidate the I-94 as documentation nor does it render the paroled Haitian ineligible for ORR benefits and services.
