SUBJECT: 8.320.6 NMAC, School-Based Services for MAP Eligible Recipients under Twenty-

One Years of Age

GENERAL INFORMATION

The New Mexico Human Services Department through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD) has finalized changes to rule, 8.320.6 NMAC, School-Based Services for MAP Eligible Recipients under Twenty-One Years of Age. The amendments to the rule were completed in order to change the current payment methodology to a cost reporting methodology that includes interim payments, a quarterly random moment time study, and annual cost settlement report. This will insure that MAD school-based service providers are reimbursed the actual costs of providing IEP or IFSP-related direct medical services.
