The Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) has issued new guidants concerning the criteria for identifying loans. The Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) Thicky 7 CFR 253.6 (e)(3)(B)(iv) states for SNAP that "loans, from whatever source, would be evidenced by a document signed by both parties."

Is a loan earned or unearned income

A loan is considered an unearry a ricon, source and is subject to mandatory verification as per regulation at 8.100.130.24 N IAC

How do I verify the valdity of a loan

Regulation at 8.100. 20.24 (K) NMAC states that verification of loan must contain the name of the person making the kein, the amount of the loan, date the loan was made and the repayment arrangement for the loan. We dictates also states that in addition to the four criteria listed above, a loan must loo be fixed by both parties.

Do loans count as ountable income for SNAP?

No, regulation at 8.139.520.9 (D) (11) NMAC states all loans, including loans from private individuals as well as commercial institutions, other than educational loans on which payment is deferred is **excluded** income.
