RE: Moratorium for Utility Vendors

DATE: October 15, 2014

The Moratorium on disconnection of utilities w. Istant povember 15, 2014. Regulated utility companies cannot disconnect service to quantied by income customers between November 15, 2014 and March 15, 2015, unless disconnection prequested by the customer. To qualify for the moratorium protection, low income lousehold must be current on their payments and/or payment arrangements on November 15, 2014. If a household is not protected against disconnection because of not epayment, protection can be re-established if the household becomes current at any time bring the moratorium period.

Households may qualify for protection from disconnection during the moratorium period because the horsehold ecceived benefits from an ISD administered program with income limits at or below 15% of the federal poverty guidelines. The benefit approval notice issued by ISD can be presented to the utime, vendor as proof of eligibility for the moratorium protection. In order to receive a LIHE P benefit, customers will have to apply for LIHEAP and be determined eligible to receive assistance.
