Amended Scope of Work

- 8. The EQRO will design and conduct a random monthly Service Plan determination audit in accordance with the 1115 Demonstration Waiver STCs to ensure the adequacy of Service Plans for HCBS participants.
 - HSD will deliver a NOD to the EQRO defining the sampling criteria and sampling methodology to be applied during the development of the project plan. The EQRO project deliverables will include the following:
 - a. Define and develop a project plan for reviewing the adequacy of Service Plans for HCBS participants.
 - b. Develop a random sampling data collection methodology from each MCO to determine the adequacy of the following quality measurers and assurances:
 - 1. Choice of waiver services and providers.
 - 2. Service plans address all assessed needs and personal goals.
 - 3. Services are delivered in accordance with the service plans including the type, scope, amount, duration, and frequency specified in the service plan.
 - 4. Ensure that children, youth, and adults are afforded linkage to protective services (e.g. Ombudsmen services, Protection and Advocacy, Division of Children Protection and Permanency) through all service entities, including the MCOs.
 - c. Report findings of the Service Plan Determinations on a quarterly and annual basis to HSD.
